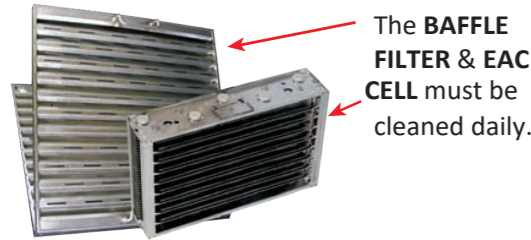


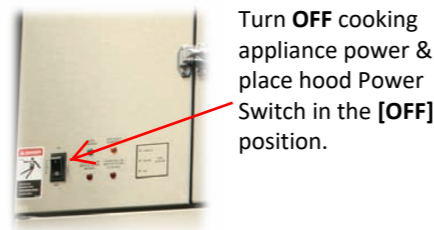
# GVH-C VENTLESS HOOD CLEANING & TROUBLESHOOTING

## Cleaning Instructions

### STEP 1: DAILY CLEANING



### STEP 2: TURN POWER OFF



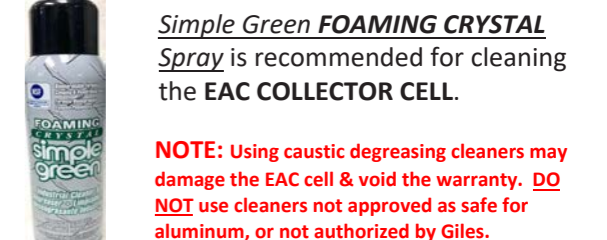
### STEP 3: REMOVE FILTER ACCESS COVER or OPEN FILTER DOOR



### STEP 4: REMOVE EAC COLLECTOR CELL



### STEP 5: CLEANING AGENT



### STEP 6: APPLY SPRAY DEGREASER



### STEP 7: APPLY ONTO ALL GREASE BUILD-UP



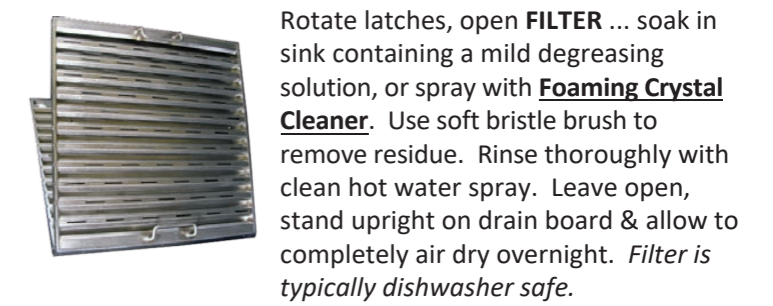
### STEP 8: RINSE & DRY OVERNIGHT



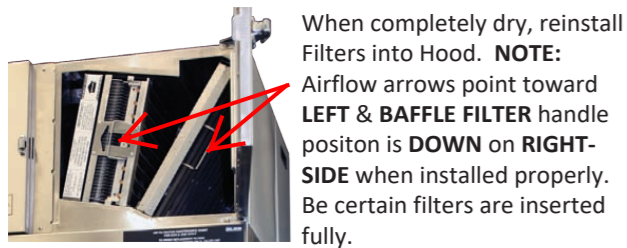
### STEP 9: REMOVE BAFFLE FILTER



### STEP 10: CLEAN BAFFLE FILTER



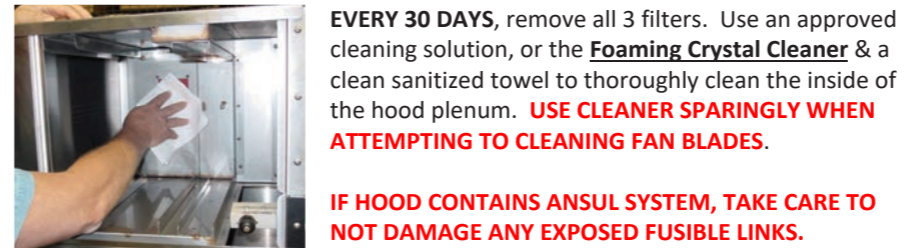
### STEP 11: REINSTALL FILTERS



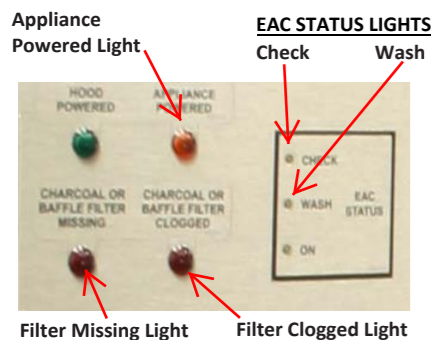
### STEP 12: CHARCOAL FILTER MAINTENANCE



### STEP 13: MONTHLY FILTER CABINET CLEANING



**NOTE:** All models have interlocks which prevent the hood from operating & powering the cooking appliance if filters are missing, damaged, or in need of cleaning. Any attempt to bypass these interlocks devices can possibly void the factory warranty.
